

NICENE CREED





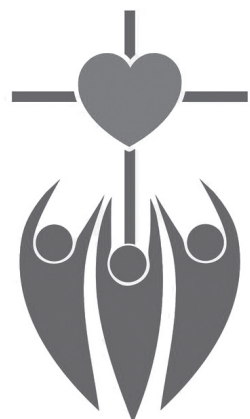
