

Confirmation Year 1 – Covenant

Candidates, Sponsors and Families will be prepared spiritually, catechetically, theologically and pastorally to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. The process utilizes a variety of settings, gatherings and events to deepen the Candidate's faith commitment, clarify the understanding of full initiation, and evangelize. This means everything is important, particularly attendance. The schedule is spread out and does accommodate holidays, and school calendars to the best of our ability.

Expectations:

- 1. A clear understanding that <u>all requirements</u> are mandatory and must be completed by the candidate and supported by family.
- 2. An authentic willingness to participate and strengthen your faith.

Requirements:

- Full, conscious and active participation at home, school, youth ministry & Confirmation prep. Example: fulfilling responsibilities (chores, homework, attending classes, etc.)
- Attend Catholic Mass with your family regularly (every Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation), preferably the 6:00p.m. Teen Mass
- Attend classes, meetings, retreats as noted on calendar
- Meet with the Coordinator- Teen and at least one parent
- Service in the parish and community through various ministry opportunities (15 Hours)- A minimum of 10 hours must be done at CCOP, Due by May 31st, 2025. Hours should be pre-approved by coordinator in advance.
- Participation in a 6:00p.m. Mass job a minimum of 4 times (these do not count for service hours).
- Attend a minimum of 2 Youth Ministry Social Events, Youth Groups or Church events.
- Attend at least one of the Triduum services at CCOP or another Catholic Church
- Attend Stations of the Cross at least 1 time during Lent
- Attend at least one day of the Parish Mission (encouraged to attend with Parent or Sponsor)
- Go to Reconciliation a minimum of two times One each during Advent and Lent
- Proof of your Baptism (even if baptized at CCOP) ASAP. You will be notified if this is not on file
- Code of Conduct and Covenants signed by Teen and at least one parent/guardian

All Year One requirements must be met before you can start Year Two of Confirmation Preparation.


At any time should the teen, or a member of your family choose to break this covenant, or Code of Conduct you may be asked to leave the program.

If, after reviewing the requirements, you see any potential conflicts, it is your (the teen candidate, supported by parent,) responsibility to express the concerns to the youth minister immediately. Issues will be addressed on a case by case basis. Thank you for understanding.
