

Confirmation Year 2 – Covenant

Candidates, sponsors and families will be prepared spiritually, catechetically, theologically and pastorally to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation. The process utilizes a variety of settings, gatherings and events to deepen the candidate's faith commitment, clarify the understanding of full initiation, and evangelize. Everything is important, particularly attendance. The schedule is spread out to accommodate holidays & school calendars to the best of our ability.

EXPECTATIONS

1. A clear understanding that all requirements are mandatory and must be completed by the candidate and supported by family.
2. An authentic willingness to participate and strengthen your faith.

REQUIREMENTS

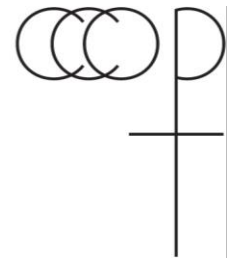
- Attend Catholic Mass with your family regularly (every Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation), preferably the 6:00p.m. Teen Mass
- Participation in 6:00p.m. Mass (as an Usher/Greeter, Bringing up the Gifts, Altar Server or choir) a minimum of 4 times (these do not count for service hours)
- Service in the parish through various ministry opportunities or outside Non-profit charity-based organization (20 Hours)- 10 hours must be done at CCOP, the additional 10 may be done at an outside organization. Hours should be preapproved by coordinator. Due by May 1st, 2025
- Code of Conduct signed by Teen and at least one parent/guardian
- Full, conscious and active participation at home, school, youth ministry & Confirmation prep: Example: fulfilling responsibilities (chores, homework, attending classes, etc.)
- Attend classes, meetings, retreats as noted on calendar – Including a weekend Confirmation Retreat and 1-day Sponsor Retreat
- Attend 2 Youth Ministry Social Events, youth group or church socials
- Attend a minimum of two Reconciliations – One each during Advent and Lent
- The selection of a Sponsor who will attend occasional meetings
- Attend a minimum of one of the Triduum services at CCOP or another Catholic Church
- Attend at least one day of the Parish Mission (encouraged to attend with Parent or Sponsor)
- Complete Assignments - Confirmation Name saint assignment and Statement of Faith/Personal Creed
- Proof of your Baptism (even if baptized at CCOP) and Fill out the Sacrament Information Form
- Attend Stations of the Cross (Date TBA) with sponsor or parent.
- Attend Confirmation Rehearsal – TBA

At any time should the teen, or a member of your family choose to break this covenant, or Code of Conduct you may be asked to leave the program.

If, after reviewing the requirements, you see any potential conflicts, it is your (the teen candidate, supported by parent,) responsibility to express the concerns to the youth minister immediately. Issues will be addressed on a case by case basis. Thank you for understanding.

Youth Ministry Covenant/Code of Conduct

If I violate any condition of this agreement, I understand that my parents / guardians will be contacted and asked to pick me up immediately. I will not be readmitted into future gatherings until my parents / guardians, youth ministry leader and I meet to discuss my future participation.
